## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- It is mandatory that all participants read and thoroughly understand all the rules and regulations before signing this entry form.
- All Federal, State, and Local laws are to be observed.
- This will be a "trailer tournament" meaning you may launch anywhere on the designated lake. Teams may launch
  anytime and proceed out at any time of the day of the tournament, but MUST HAVE AND USE PROPER
  RUNNING LIGHTS, PEDS AND PROCEED WITH CAUTION AND COURTESY.
- Five fish limit.
- Fish must be alive.
- No live bait.
- A U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD must be worn and fastened while the combustion engine is in gear. NO EXCEPTIONS. All boats must meet U.S. Coast Guard standards and outboards cannot exceed the maximum HIP rating for that boat. Boats must have a kill switch that is attached to the driver while the engine is in gear.
- No trolling with the big motor.
- In case of a tie, the two places will be averaged and paid the same.
- All decisions of the tournament directors are final.
- No non contestants are allowed in the boat during tournament hours.
- Must be in weigh in line by 3:00 pm or you will be disqualified. The cell phone time of the check in person will be the official time.
- Pay entry fee morning of tournament or online before event. Cash, no checks.
- Short fish will be bumped 1lb. penalty per fish plus the loss of the fish. This includes every species of bass. (AKA) Spotted or Kentucky Bass.
- Guides or anyone that bass fishes with a guide in the last two weeks are ineligible.
- All contestants are required and expected to follow a high standard of courtesy and sportsmanship during the tournament and weigh in. This includes respecting other anglers, both tournament and non-tournament.
   Complaints for discourteous conduct will be handled as an infraction of the rules.
- Alcohol and/or narcotics will not be allowed in a contestant's possession during the tournament hours.
   Exception will be legal prescriptions.
- Boats with an operating live well with an aerator system are preferred, but not mandatory. Teams must cull on the 6th fish.

By signing this form, I hereby release all other contestants, officials, hosts and sponsors from any and all damages, claims, or expenses relating to or resulting from this tournament, including personal injury and/or damages. Ages 16 and under must have a parent or legal guardian signature.
